Dear Friends of Missions,

Thank you so much for praying! We know that God answers prayer. Our colleges and universities need us to intercede for them, now more than ever. We need a move of God to sweep across these schools of higher education. We need to see a revival among our Christian students, staff and faculty. A revival there will spread to an awakening across the whole campus. God has done it before, He certainly can do it again.

Jesus asked us to pray for laborers: Luke 10.2 *“The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore, plead with the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest”* (NASB). We at Chi Alpha are asking you to *“plead”* with the Lord of the harvest. We believe that God wants to send an awakening to America, and that it will start on the college campus! We need your help.

In this guide, like the last, we have tried to find all the Christian organizations on each campus. It is likely that we missed a few. For example, we only know of those churches which are reaching out to campuses if they are listed on the college’s website. So, if you are reaching out to students, and you are not listed in this prayer guide, please forgive us. Let us know, and if there are future prayer guides will include you.

Pray for the leaders of these Christian groups. They are the “soldiers on the front lines”. Some of them may not even know that they are in a spiritual warfare. Pray that the Holy Spirit wakes them to that fact. Some of the schools hide the student leader’s names. We acknowledged that with a question marked.

You will notice that several schools have chaplains and ministry staff. We never know where they stand. Pray that God works in them and through them. Finally, we did find the names of some of the student group advisors. This is a plus. Most of the time a

Christian student group advisor is a Christian themselves. They too are soldiers on the front line. An added bonus that comes with recognizing an advisor is that they are more “stable”. Normally student leaders are voted on every year, whereas the advisor, like the chaplains and ministry leaders on campus, stay in their position for years at a time.

This is now the second installment of the New York Ministry Network’s Chi Alpha Collegiate Prayer Guide. There are eight scheduled. Given the quantity of schools in New York we had to scheduled eight, and because of that, the number of schools per month will vary. We did not want to end-up with the last prayer guide only having seven or ten entries.

This prayer guide was compiled with data from the list found at “The National Center for Education Statistics” ([NCES](#)) and from each school’s own website. For the international student statistics, we used a website called [“College Factual”](#). The international statistics are under the “Student Life” tab.

Thank You again for investing time into this next generation. Only eternity will tell what we helped along and what we were able to hinder.

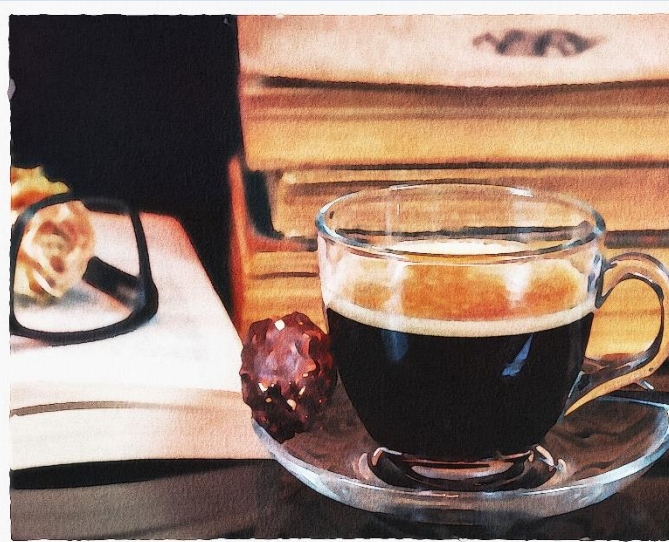

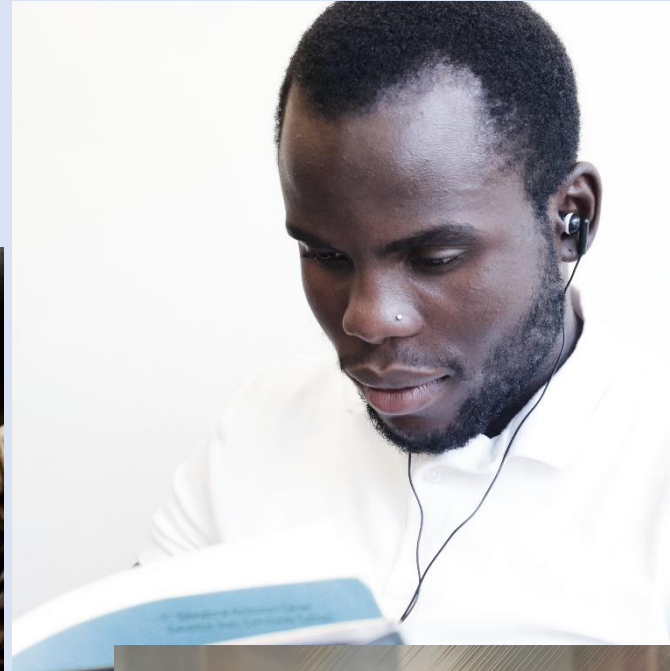

“Concordia College is **closing its doors** when the fall 2021 semester begins, according to a Thursday announcement.

Iona College will acquire Concordia's Bronxville campus and allow its students to finish their degrees with Iona. Concordia, a liberal arts college that has been operating in New York since 1881, has about 1,500 students.

The campus, about 33 acres, will be used to develop a school of health sciences for Iona, furthering the institution's investment in the field and continuing Concordia's "legacy of excellence in health sciences education," according to the announcement, which was made by both colleges.”
