Dear Friends of Missions,

This is the second volume for the Northwest Ministry Network Collegiate Prayer Guide. It is with a grateful heart that we want to say THANK YOU! Thank you for taking the time to pray for college students, staff and faculty. The college is a very strategic mission field. We know that and so too does the enemy. The Covid-19 season has been a very difficult time for college students. Your prayers are needed now more than ever.

The Spring 2021 Semester has been slightly better than the Spring and Fall of 2020. Most schools have opened up to some degree. Some are still not allowing students on campus. As the summer progresses the Fall of 2021 should be fairly normal, as if normal is ever going to rear its head again.







"First, for Winter quarter 2021, all classes will be distance learning only; there will be no in person, face-to-face instruction in winter quarter. 



"We wanted to share an update on the preclinical curriculum plan for the Spring 2021 semester. ... campus will return to Level 1 status, as defined in our Campus Reopening Plan, from December 12, 2020 through January 18, 2021. "Our faculty have committed to maximizing in-person instruction by using the innovative WhitworthFLEX approach, which emphasizes in-person, hybrid and modular course designs. This approach will allow students to engage with class activities and assignments no matter their individual circumstances. The specific implications of this approach will depend upon class size, a faculty member's ability to be in the classroom, and other particular needs of the course or discipline.... Because of classroom capacity constraints, many classes will employ a hybrid approach. For example, this may entail half of the class meeting in person on Tuesday and the other half of the class meeting in person on Thursday, while the half not attending class will be engaged remotely or with other components of the course's curriculum."
