*For contact tracing purposes, everyone will be required to log in at the Security Desk and identify their destination.

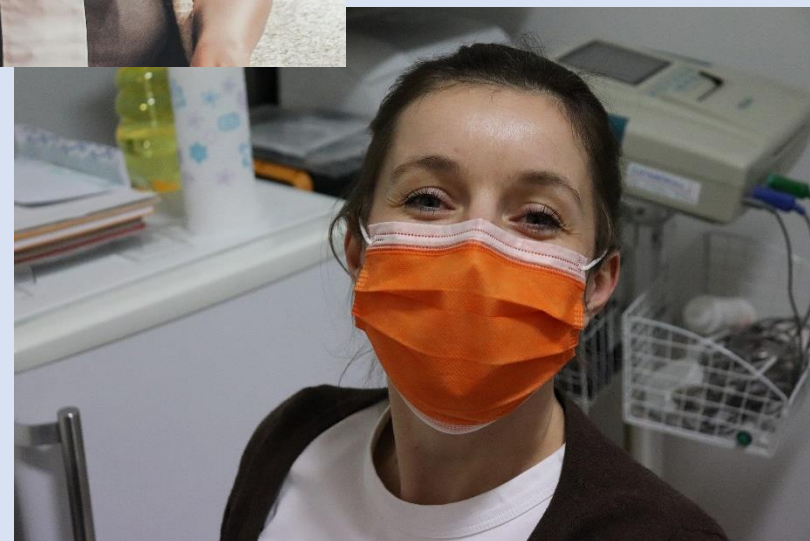
*Students will be met at the Security Desk by someone from the Student Services Division.

Covid-19 Update:

“YOUR POD IS the people with whom you live. Think of your pod like your family at home – people you are with all the time. The key thing to remember is to avoid going from one pod to another, because that is how the virus spreads.
