Dear Friends,

This is now the second of two prayer guides, created specifically for the New Jersey Ministry Network of the Assemblies of God. We have created these prayer guides to help churches and individuals be proactive in ministry toward college and university students, staff, and faculty. Our simple goal is to do what Jesus asked us to do, pray for laborers: Luke 10.2 *“The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore, plead with the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest”* (NASB).

The New American Standard Bible translation uses the word “*plead*”. What a powerful word. We are to plead with God for more laborers. We believe that God wants to send a revival to the campuses of America and we need the workers to be in place! We need your help.

We know that, through prayer, God still changes “things”. Thank you, in advance, for your participation in this vital ministry. God answers prayer! In the past ten years we have seen an increase of over 169% in Chi Alpha workers. That is awesome! But we have much more ground to cover. According to the everycampus.com website more than 2,000 campuses in the USA still have no known Gospel witness.

In this prayer guide, we have highlighted each of the Christian organizations on each campus, that we could find. (It is likely that we missed a few.) Please pray for the student leaders of the Christian groups listed. They are the “soldiers on the front lines”. Some of them may not even know that they are in spiritual warfare. Pray that the Holy Spirit awakens them to that fact. (Some student groups show a question mark instead of a student leader. This happens only when a student leader or advisor could not be located.)

You will notice that several schools have chaplains and ministry staff. We never know where they stand on Christ, Sin, Biblical Authority, etc. Pray that, regardless of where they stand, that God works in them and through them.

Also, please notice, that on each page, we have included several prayer requests. These prayer requests are provided as a template. Ask God to show you how to pray for each school. Do not be “hemmed in” by the prayer requests listed.

This prayer guide was compiled with data from the list found at “The National Center for Education Statistics” ([NCES](http://nces.gov)) and from each school’s own website. For the international student statistics, we used a website called “[College Factual](http://CollegeFactual.com)”. The international statistics are under the “Student Life” tab.

Thank You again for investing time into this next generation. Only eternity will tell what we helped along and what we were able to hinder.
