Sadly, you will notice that many schools have no known gospel witness at all. We are believing God to raise up workers for these schools.

As you pray, please remember to pray for the students who live in student housing. You will notice that each school listed below will have a spot to show whether they have student housing or not. A lot of really crazy stuff happens in dorms, especially co-ed dorms!

There is a section on each page for "generic" recommended prayer ideas. Please see this as springboard for prayer. Allow the Holy Spirit to lead you beyond what has been recommended.

We have included a section on international students. We are using the <u>College Factual</u> website for all pertinent data. The international student information is under the "Student Life" tab.

Finally, we wanted to let you know that this prayer guide was compiled with data from each school's individual website, as well as the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES). We only included schools which offer at least an associate's degree and have a student population of over 350.

Thank you once again, in advance, for investing time into this next generation. Only eternity will tell what we helped along and what we were able to hinder with our prayers.




